


What size should I cut the fabric?

When making a half square triangle, cut two fabric squares %" larger than the desired **finished** size of your half square triangle.

Steps:

- 1. Start with two fabric squares, each \%" larger than the desired **finished** size of your half square triangle.
- 2. On the wrong side of the lightest square, draw a diagonal line corner to corner. (1)
- 3. Place the two squares right side together and stitch a seam 1/4" from the drawn line, on either side of the line. (2)
- 4. Cut apart along the drawn line and press open, pressing the seam toward the darker fabric. (3 & 4)

 You should now have two identical half square triangles exactly ½" larger than your desired finished block.
