## What size should I cut the fabric?

When making a half square triangle, cut two fabric squares $7 / 8$ " larger than the desired finished size of your half square triangle.

## Steps:

1. Start with two fabric squares, each $7 / 8 "$ larger than the desired finished size of your half square triangle.
2. On the wrong side of the lightest square, draw a diagonal line corner to corner. (1)
3. Place the two squares right side together and stitch a seam $1 / 4$ " from the drawn line, on either side of the line. (2)
4. Cut apart along the drawn line and press open, pressing the seam toward the darker fabric. (3 \& 4)

You should now have two identical half square triangles exactly $1 / 2$ " larger than your desired finished block.
