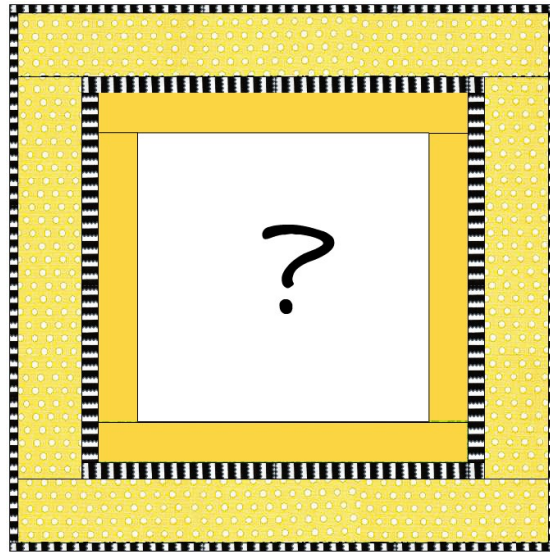




# 16" x 16" Pillow Cover

with Bound Edge



This pattern contains general instructions make a 16" x 16" pillow cover with a bound edge using any 9" x 9" (finished) quilt block or panel of your choice.

## *Fabric Requirements*

A 9 ½" x 9 ½" (unfinished) quilt block

¼ yd fabric A (Innermost border)

1 Fat Quarter (18" x 22") fabric B (Narrow border & Binding)

¼ yd fabric C (Outside border)

18" x 18" backing fabric

18" x 18" batting

½ yd fabric for an envelope style pillow back

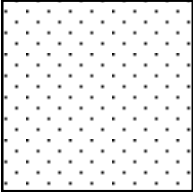

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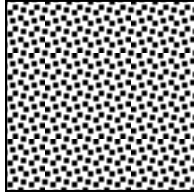
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# Pillow Cover Instructions

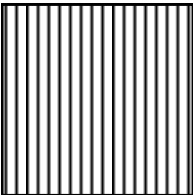
Fabric A



Fabric C

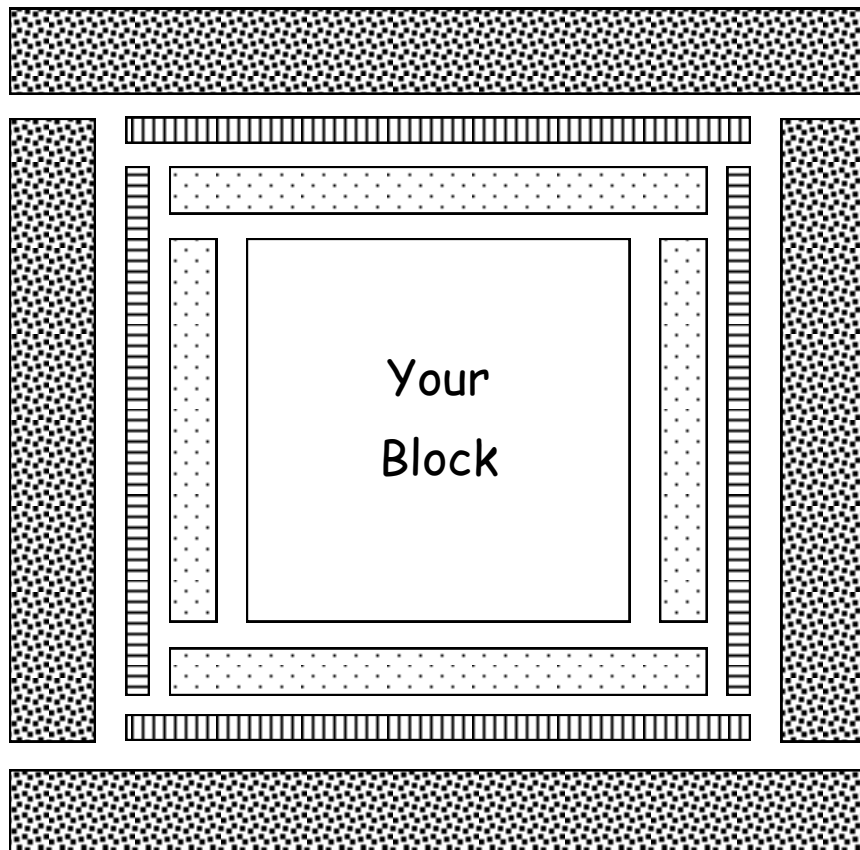


Fabric B



Cut fabric as follows:

Fabric	No. of Pieces	Size
A	2	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
A	2	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 12"
B	2	1" x 12"
B	2	1" x 13"
B	1	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 80"
C	2	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13"
C	2	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 17"



## Assembly

1. Using your block as the center block, cut and attach the borders as shown in the diagram on page 3.
2. Layer & baste the pillow top and quilt as desired. Trim to 16½" x 16½".
2. Make 80" of binding using 2½" wide strips of Fabric B.
3. Out of pillow back fabric cut two sections 16½" x 12".
4. Fold over ⅜" along the long (16½") side of each section toward the wrong side of the fabric.
5. Repeat, folding the fabric over a second time.
6. Sew ⅛" from the outside edge to secure the seam.
7. Lay the quilted pillow front right side down on the table. Place one pillow back section right side up on top of it, lining up the raw edges. Pin into place.
8. Place the other pillow back section right side up on top, once again lining up the raw edges and overlapping the first section.
9. Machine baste along the edge using a ⅛" seam to secure all layers. (It can be a little wider as long as it's less than ¼" or you'll have to remove the basting afterwards.)
10. Attach the binding as you would on any other quilt.
